

## CALCULATING YOUR GRADES

Are you trying to figure out what you need to make next semester to get the grade you want? I wanted to share with you the way semester grades and final grades are computed.

How to calculate your semester grades:
Multiply: Q1 grade* X $0.475=$ $\qquad$
Multiply: Q2 grade* X 0.475 = $\qquad$
Multiply: Midterm grade X $0.05=$ $\qquad$
Add those answers together and this equals your $1^{\text {st }}$ semester grade.
For $2^{\text {nd }}$ semester, do the same.
Multiply: Q3 grade* $\times 0.475=$ $\qquad$
Multiply: Q4 grade* X $0.475=$ $\qquad$
Multiply: Final grade X $0.05=$ $\qquad$
Add those answers together and this equals your $\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ semester grade.
How to calculate your grade for the year:
Semester 1 grade + Semester 2 grade $=$ $\qquad$
Divide that total by 2
= Your grade for the year
*Make sure you use the grade from the comprehensive progress report and NOT the rounded grade on your report card (ex. 85.65\%, not 86\%).
